ALERT – PROPERTY OWNERS IN DOWNTOWN CREVE COEUR

The City of Creve Coeur will hold a Public Hearing on Monday, January 28, 2008, 7:00 p.m. in the Creve Coeur Government Center, 300 N. New Ballas (across from the Post Office), to consider amending its current ordinances to create a 'DT' Downtown Overlay District (Section 26-45) and Planned Unit Development (Section 26-46) within the Core Business District. THE PROPOSED ORDINANCE CHANGES THE HEIGHT, DENSITY AND SETBACK REQUIREMENTS. Also tentatively scheduled on the city's agenda is the: Rezoning of Westgate Park, Residential Development District Density, Conditional Use Permits for Phillips 66, Starbucks, and 5th 3rd Bank and West Oak Master Sign Package. This important Hearing provides an opportunity for all property owners to hear of these proposed changes and share their comments for the public record.
