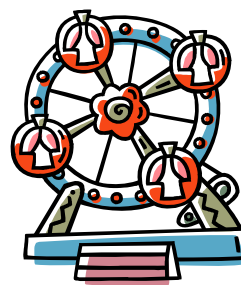

NEW AND IMPROVED OLIVETTE COMMUNITY FESTIVAL SCHEDULED FOR FALL OF 2011

The City of Olivette has held an annual community festival for almost 40 years, known as Olivette Summerfest. The festival has traditionally been held over the third weekend of June.

At the request of the Olivette City Council, a group of community volunteers is working on planning a new community festival to replace Summerfest. This new event, tentatively named "Olivette-on-the-Go", is scheduled for the weekend of September 30, October 1, and October 2, 2011. It will involve traditional events such as carnival rides and games, food, music, and community gathering. The planning committee is working on several new events, including connecting it with the Ladue Horton Watkins High School Homecoming, entertainment from local schools and other performing arts groups, an Olivette 5K run, a softball tournament, expanded food court, and a major concert with a nationally recognized entertainer. Other events are in the planning stages.

The planning committee is open to additional ideas for community-based events as well as volunteers to help make this exciting event a reality. In addition, the city is actively seeking corporate sponsors for specific events and activities.

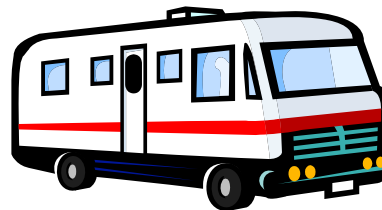

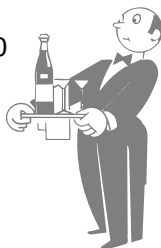
