At the January membership luncheon the Business Person of the Year was presented to Howard Weissman of the National Council on Alcoholism and Drug Abuse. Howard has been the Executive Director since 2013 and in only five years has taken an already viable agency that has competently addressed substance abuse issues in the region for many years to an even higher level of competence and community awareness. First he restructured staff and hired noted St. Louis journalist Eric Mink as the agency's primary publications writer and editor, which resulted in substantial funding increases for the agency, and allowed an eventual 20% growth in staff.

Howard secured sufficient contributions on his own to allow the agency to buy its own building in Olivette. After 48 years of leasing space, NCADA's new home at 9355 Olive Boulevard in Olivette was not only substantially larger than its previous space, it was a considerable upgrade in all respects.

Due to Howard's efforts, the agency secured funding to allow for award-winning PSAs regarding the opiate epidemic to be created and shown locally on Super Bowl broadcasts. The first PSA ran in 2016, ultimately went viral on YouTube and received attention and commendation from as far away as the Office of National Drug Control Policy in Washington, D.C. Howard was able to repeat the process, and the agency showed yet another hard-hitting, high-impact PSA in the 2017 Super Bowl with another being planned for the 2018 Super Bowl broadcast.

During Howard's tenure, NCADA received the Torch Award by the St. Louis Better Business Bureau in 2013 and was named a Top Workplace by the St. Louis Post-Dispatch.

During his acceptance remarks Howard Weissman announced he would be retiring in June and introduced his successor, Nicole Dawsey, who was also in attendance at the meeting.

Congratulations to Howard Weissman for this distinguished award!



The Community Service Award was presented to the City of Olivette for its new government center that opened in 2017. The 38,000 square foot building is the new home of Olivette City Police, Fire, Planning and Administration replacing the old City Hall, which was built in 1952.

Planning the complex started in 2013 when an adhoc committee was formed to investigate the need for a facility, review potential sites, and develop conceptual designs. The committee quickly determined that renovating the existing City Hall was not a viable option. Utilizing professional services, the committee and Council began looking at potential sites.

With real estate under contract, a preliminary design, and a cost estimate, Olivette citizens were asked to approve a \$13.5M bond to finance the project and on August 4, 2014 citizens overwhelmingly approved the bond initiative. Immediately following that success, work began on final design and engineering.

The building incorporates modern technology used to insure the safety of first responders and citizens. The Police Department's updated detention, evidence and interview areas allow for full integration of policing best practices. The Fire Department features multifunctional apparatus bays, a modern training tower and mezzanine, and improved living areas. The Planning and Community Development Department has also moved into the new facility and is housed in the administration area, enhancing coordination between departments. Original artwork may be found throughout the building, which adds color and vitality to the interior decoration. A history wall with dates and information profiles the significance of Olivette to the region. The beautiful building is a testament to the efforts of the council and staff of Olivette and our chamber congratulates them on the positive impact it has on the city.
