OLIVETTE DEDICATES NEW CITY GOVERNMENT CENTER

On April 22, Olivette residents and business owners had their first opportunity to see the new home of Olivette City Police, Fire, Planning and Administration. Located at 1140 Dielman Road, the 38,000 square foot building replaces the old City Hall, which was built in 1952.

The new facility project started in 2013 when an adhoc committee was formed to investigate the need for a facility, review potential sites, and develop conceptual designs. The committee quickly determined that renovating the existing City Hall was not a viable option. Utilizing professional services, the committee and Council began looking at potential sites. A four-acre area north of the Walgreens at Olive and Dielman rose to the top of the list.

With properties under contract, a preliminary design, and cost estimate, Olivette citizens were asked to approve a \$13.5M bond to finance the project. On August 4, 2014 citizens overwhelmingly approved the bond initiative. Immediately following that success, Archimages began work on final design and engineering. Public Works began work on demolition of homes on the site. In June of 2015 City Council approved an Owner's Representative contract with PARIC. In March of 2016, United Construction was hired as the General Contractor for the project.

The building incorporates modern technology used to insure the safety of our first responders and citizens. The Police Department's updated detention, evidence and interview areas allow for full integration of policing best practices. The Fire Department features multifunctional apparatus bays, a modern training tower and mezzanine, and improved living areas. The Planning and Community Development Department has also moved into the new facility and is housed in the administration area, enhancing coordination between departments.



Barb Sondag, Olivette City Manager, acted as emcee during the dedication ceremony. She explained Olivette was once called Central due to its centralized location along the Central Plank Road (now called Olive Boulevard). That explains the tagline, "Olivette ... in the center of it all". Price Road and Olive Boulevard intersect at the exact midpoint between the Port of St. Louis on the Mississippi River and Howell's Landing on the Missouri River. Central became the best stop for wagons to restock on their journey between the two stops.

State Senator Jill Schupp and State Representative Tracy McCreery gave remarks followed with reflective comments by Reverend Rory Karg from Immanuel Lutheran Church and Dr. Kathy Boyd-Fenger from Logos School. Both institutions have meaningful history in the Olivette community. The Immanuel Lutheran Church has been located in Olivette for 170 years. The Logos School site was home to the first brick schoolhouse in St. Louis County at the corner of Price and Old Bonhomme, its building dating back 150 years.

After remarks from Police Chief Rick Knox, Fire Chief Scott Avery, City Manager Barbara Sondag, Councilmember Missy Waldman and Mayor Ruth Springer, the council and honored guests participated in a ribbon cutting ceremony.

Maps aided people as they toured the building and were able to view parts of the building that would become off-limits after the tours, such as the evidence room, cells, firefighters' bedrooms and lounge areas and fitness room. Some people chose to use the slide from the firefighters section down to where the fire engines and ambulances are housed.

Original artwork may be found throughout the building, which adds color and vitality to the interior decorations. A history wall with dates and information profiles the significance of Olivette to the region.

Congratulations to Olivette for this beautiful state-of-the-art government center!

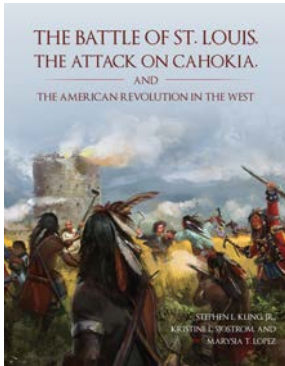

Critical to the defense were Spanish Lieutenant Governor Fernando de Leyba and the stone tower built and paid for by Leyba himself and the citizens of St. Louis. While coordinating several separate attacks, the centerpiece of the grand plan was the descent from the north by a huge British-led Indian force upon St. Louis and Cahokia. Had these attacks been successful, it is likely the British would have retained these areas after the war, greatly altering the history of our country.
